SERVING TOGETHER PRAYER IDEAS

Intercessory prayer is praying on behalf of someone else.
Here are some ideas to get you started.

Fingerprint prayers

You will need:

Card stock – either postcard size for individual prayers
or A4 or A3 poster size for family/group prayers

Textas, pencils, pens, crayons

Paint on small paper plates or in small containers

Wet wipes



What to do:

1. Write down the names of people you want to pray for or situations you wish to pray for.
2. To show your commitment to praying for these people or situations dip your finger into the paint provided and put your fingerprint next to those whom you will pray for.
3. You might consider displaying your prayers somewhere as a visual reminder to keep praying.

Airplane prayers

What to do:

Write down your prayer requests on a piece of A4 paper.
Fold it into a paper airplane. Stand in a circle with others and throw
your planes into the middle of the circle.

Everyone picks up someone else's prayer plane. Read their request and either pray
around the circle out loud or each pray silently for the other person in the group.
