## **KIDS IN WORSHIP**

Someone to take care of us

“What a wonderful mother, she will make”, Eddie said. He was happy to see his pet collie with her puppies. While they slept, she lay nearby, watching them all the time (*see slide of collie and puppies*).

\* Will she ever let them out of her sight?”, Eddie asks his mum.

“Probably not!”, answered his mum. “She will watch over them all the time until they can take care of themselves. Even at night, the slightest whimper from one of her puppies will wake her up”.

Eddie asked this mum, “Is that how God watches over us?”

\* How do you think that Eddie’s mum answered Eddie?

*Yes, that’s right. She said, “That’s exactly how God watches over us. Only He does an even better job. The Bible says that He never sleeps (Psalm 121:1-3).*

“Is He watching over us right now?”, Eddie asked.

“Of course He is”, said Eddie’s mum. He loves you and He watching over you and caring for you, *just like your pet collie dog is watching over her pups, only better”*

- \* One last question to you before we have our song. Do you think that God cares for you, and that He will look after you and care for you, even when you are sick or scared?

*Yes, of course He will*

By the way, how do you know that He loves you and will care for you?  
*Through the Bible, and through Jesus, God’s Son, that’s right! As we read the stories about Jesus in The Beginner’s Bible like the story of Jesus healing a man born blind, we are reminded that this is how God cares for us.*

*And when we see Jesus on the cross, it reminds us just how much God loves us (See slide of being sick, plus slide of The Beginner’s Bible)*

- \* The Veggie Tales have a song which reminds us of that God loves us and is caring for us. It’s called “God is bigger”
