### Discussion Questions:

1. When we sing “Shalom, my friends” (ATA #195), what do you think we mean by the word “Shalom”? Have you heard the word used in any other contexts, *for example, as a greeting?*
2. Most people spend their life living with an absence of Shalom, peace with God. How do people in our society and around the world strive to find Shalom? *Talk about how people use alcohol, drugs, sex, money, holidays, family, and work in an attempt to find Shalom.*

3. What characterises life apart from God?

*Talk about the ways in which dissatisfaction, meaninglessness, guilt, shame, and fear are part of life without God.*

What films, books, or songs give you a glimpse of all this?

Have you friends who have shared with you honestly about what life apart from God is like?

4. How can we have “Shalom”, peace with God?

*Read again what Paul says in Romans 5:1*

What does this mean for your life?

How would you go about sharing this with a friend?

5. We can look at the future, and stare death in the face, without fear or worry. *Go on reading what Paul says in Romans 5 verses 2-5, and then 6-9.*

What is the basis of our hope for the future?
