KIDS IN WORSHIP:

Being kind to your neighbour

- * Can I ask you, “Do you know your neighbours at all?” What are their names? Do they have any young people who you can play with?
- * God wants us to “love your neighbour as you love yourself” (Lev. 19:18). Do you think that this means just the people who live next door to us? Or the people who we know?
- * Someone once asked Jesus this: “Who is my neighbour?”

Jesus answered him by telling him a story.

- * So who is our neighbour? And who does God want us to be a neighbour to?
