CHILDREN'S MESSAGE QUESTIONS:

- * Do you like going to the beach? Do you like building sandcastles on the beach? What happens to them when the tide, *the sea water*, comes in?
- * Jesus said that if we build a house, it is much better to build on solid ground rather than on sandy ground. If you were to build a house out of Lego blocks, what would you rather build on? Rock or sand? What house would be more secure? *Try doing this as a Lighthouse activity this morning.*
- * And it's the same with our life, Jesus said. It is not sensible to build our life on things that aren't secure: things, like money, or possessions, or importance. Jesus said that the wise person is the person who hears Jesus' words and does them. What do you think?
