**Discussion Questions:**

- 1) What do you think of the healing miracles of Jesus in our focus verses for today from Matthew's Gospel: the healings of the leper, the centurion's servant, Peter's mother, the demon possessed, and “all who were sick”? Discuss our Bible reading among yourselves.
- 2) Why do you think that Jesus did miracles of healing?  
What were his miracles “signs” of? *Read Matt. 11:4-6; Isaiah 35:5-6; Matt. 16:13-16; John 20:31-32.*  
What did Jesus' miracles point forward to? *Read Rev.21:1-5.*

3) Have you ever thought to yourself:

**“Well, Jesus healed people back then. Surely he can still heal people now.... So why isn't he healing me, or my loved one, as I cry out to him for healing? Have I not got enough faith, or doesn't he think that I deserve healing or that my loved one deserves healing?”**

Talk about situations in your life, or in the life of loved ones, when you have ever wondered this. What conclusions did you come to?

4) What does God encourage us, His children, to do in time of sickness and suffering? Reflect on the following:

- \* **Jesus encourages us to pray to our dear Father**
- \* **Pray “Your will be done”**
- \* **Ask for strength to cope**
- \* **Pray that God will use your situation for His glory**

5) The writer of the letter to the Hebrews urges us always to keep our eyes on Jesus (*Heb. 12:1-2*). How does that help us in times of sickness and suffering?
