“Love one another...”

- * What do you want to do with your life?
What do you want to be when you grow up?
A fireman, a nurse, a teacher, a doctor....
- * You know, regardless of what you do when you grow up, God wants you to do one thing for Him now. Do you know what it is?
Yes, to love one another, no matter who they are, or what pickle they have got themselves in.
