## KIDS IN WORSHIP

### “Two miracles” from the Beginner’s Bible

- \* Do you ever feel scared about what’s going to happen to you in the future?  
*Guess what, I do too! We can worry that we’ll get sick, and maybe even worse than that....*
- \* I want to tell you a story this morning that reminds us that no matter what happens to us in the future, Jesus is with you and me and he’s looking after us....

And I want to remind you that Jesus has a wonderful future in store for us.

- \* The story that I want to tell you is from THE BEGINNER’S BIBLE called “Two miracles”.  
It’s about how Jesus healed a woman, and brought a little girl back to life....

- \* Jesus cared for the woman who was sick, and the little girl who had died.... And Jesus cares for you and me too.

So we don’t need to be scared of the future...

Jesus is with us, caring for us, *just like he cared for that woman who was sick, and that little girl who died.* Jesus promises us, “I will be with you always” (Matt. 28:20).

And one day we will see Jesus again. He will come again and take us home to be with him, and then everything will be new: there will be no more sickness, and no more death or dying.

In the song, “Jesus died upon the cross”, Colin Buchanan reminds us of that Jesus will come again, and we will see Jesus. Colin sings, and he wants us to sing:

**He’s coming back again”**

Who’s “coming back again”?
