\* What did Claudia the caterpillar turn into?

*Claudia, the butterfly!*

Let me read to you again from the last couple of pages of the story:

**Then the chrysalis shook. Rip. Out popped Claudia – good old Claudia, wonderful new Claudia.**

**She flexed and flapped...and flew.**

**“This is the life”, cried Claudia as she went flying and gliding, winging and wheeling across the sky.**

\* Why do you think that the caterpillar being changed into being a butterfly is a great reminder of what happened at Easter?

*Like the caterpillar was put in a chrysalis, or cocoon, so Jesus was put into a tomb. Just as the caterpillar came out of the cocoon as a wonderful new butterfly, so Jesus came out of his tomb with a wonderful new body.*

\* And will be the same with us too.... Jesus is alive now, and even if we die, and are put in a cocoon, one day Jesus will come and give us wonderful new bodies. And we will live with Jesus for ever!
