CHILDREN'S MESSAGE Love like Jesus loves

- * Jesus told lots of stories with a point to them, called “parables”. Can I ask you, “What is your favourite story that Jesus told?”
 - *The Good Samaritan*
 - *The Lost Son*
 - *The Pharisee and the Tax Collector*

- * This morning, we're going to think about Jesus' story of “The Good Samaritan”.
If you are at home or in church, you can read this story in *The Beginner's Bible* (p. 379) or watch an online version at:
https://youtu.be/Cy_Kg5yC5Tg

- Or if you are at the picnic, you can act it out as I retell it to you.... We need:
 - ❖ A man travelling on the road from Jerusalem to Jericho
 - ❖ Three robbers, who beat him up, steal all his belonging, including his clothes, and leave him lying “half dead” on the side of the road
 - ❖ A priest, who walk on by on the other side of the road
 - ❖ A Levite, an assistant to the priest, who also walks on by on the other side of the road
 - ❖ A Samaritan, someone from another country, who the Jews didn't like at all....

- * The Good Samaritan stops and helps the man. Jesus says that the Samaritan 'was filled with pity' for the man lying there.

What does he do to help the man?

- ❖ He pours oil and wine on the man's wounds and bandages them (*act this out*)
 - ❖ He puts him on his donkey and takes him into town (*act this out with a helper being the donkey*)
 - ❖ He pays an innkeeper to look after him, and says that he will pay the innkeeper "whatever else you spend on him".
- * Then Jesus says to the Lawyer, the person who he is telling the story to, "You go, then, and do likewise"

And that's what Jesus is saying to us, too:

"You go, then, and do likewise". "Go, and love others, just like the Good Samaritan does in Jesus' story"

- * Do you think that Jesus loves us like the Good Samaritan loved that man?
You bet, he does. Jesus loves us. He is willing to do virtually anything for us. In fact, he did! He even suffered and died "for our sins" on the cross. That's how much he loves us!!

- * And Jesus goes on loving us, doesn't he!?
Let's sing about how much Jesus loves us.
Jesus loves us, no matter how big or small we are, no matter how clever or smart we are,, no matter what our skin colour is....

Let's sing Colin's song: "Jesus loves the little children"
