CHILDREN’S MESSAGE The Lost Sheep:
“God loves you this much!!”

- * Who loves you?
Mum, dad, brothers and sisters, grandparents, cousins, friends
 - * Do you think that God loves you?
Yes, He loves you and me and everyone very much!!
 - * Jesus told a story which reminds us how much God loves you. It’s the story of “The Lost Sheep”, which is found in *The Beginner’s Bible* (p.391). But I thought that this morning, I’d show you another version on YouTube: <https://youtu.be/Ry2MaMyvGo>
 - * So how much do you think that God loves you? This much (*put hands 10 cm apart*),
This much (*put hands 30 cm apart*), this much (*put hands and arms outstretched, like being on a cross*).
- Yes, that’s how much God loves you and me: enough to suffer and to die on the cross for us!!
- * Let’s sing a song that reminds us that God loves each of us very, very much. It’s called “God loves you”
