KIDS IN WORSHIP

“What is important in life”

- * Focus: On what is important in life:
having JESUS as our Saviour, and having peace with God
- * Prop: A rubbish bin, and bits of rubbish, unimportant things
- * Show the boys and girls your rubbish bin.
Ask: “Have you got rubbish bins at home?”
“What do you put in them? Rubbish, things that aren’t really important to you, things that you want to throw away.

What do you keep? The things that are really important to you. What things are really important to you, and which you would never throw away? Maybe, your favourite doll, your football, your basketball, your favourite toy.

- * What about JESUS? Would you ever throw him away? No! In our Bible reading, Paul says JESUS is the most important thing in the world for him. Why do you think Paul says this?
Because he is our Saviour, the One who rescues us, and the One through whom we have PEACE WITH GOD.

- * Colin Buchanan has a song called 'The greatest treasure in the whole wide world', in which he first talks about things that aren't *really* important, things like:
 - Getting 'stuff', possessions
 - Having "the trickiest things that money can buy"
 - Being "a star"
 - Getting "the biggest house and the flashiest car"

...And in which he reminds us that "the greatest treasure in the whole wide world is "PEACE WITH GOD", through having JESUS as our Saviour, *our Rescuer*.
