

## IN WORSHIP TODAY

Our Bible Readings for our Church@Home are as follow:

For the 9am worship service, they are [Genesis 18:1 – 15](#) [Romans 5:1 – 8](#).

The Gospel reading is [Matthew 7:21 – 27](#).

For the 10.30am worship service, the bible reading is [Matthew 7:21 – 27](#).

The theme and message for both worship services is “Build your life on the Lord Jesus Christ” which is based on [Matthew 7:24 – 27](#).

Well, life has certainly been a bit different in the last few months or so, hasn't it? Things are easing up somewhat now, but life in this Corona virus pandemic time has been very different.... We have been doing all sorts of things in order to try to have a secure life, *rather than an insecure life: social distancing, washing our hands, keeping to ourselves, and so on....* Now I'm not knocking any of these: I think that they are vitally important to save lives and to enable us to function as a society....

But the question that I want us to think about this morning is: “How can you and I built a secure life without fear, *regardless of what is happening around us?*” Well Jesus tells us how in our Bible reading for today, and the children's song that we sang before sums it up:

**So, build your life on the Lord Jesus Christ**  
**Build your life on the Lord Jesus Christ**  
**Build your life on the Lord Jesus Christ**  
**And the blessings will come down**

That's our theme for today is: “Build your life on the Lord Jesus Christ”. As we trust in Jesus as our Saviour, and live our life before God our loving Father in heaven, we don't need to be afraid, regardless of what is happening or will happen. We have “peace” with God, we have an inner “joy” that no one or nothing can ever take away, and we have a certain “hope” for the future.





# UPDATE REGARDING ETERNITY NEWS



When I started Eternity newspaper, I thought it would last five years before spinning off an internet news service which would take its place.

I was wrong. Eternity has been published for more than ten years, reaching edition number 109 this year. The edition you received in April, though, will be the last. The coronavirus - which has brought me back to write this note on the same dining table that the paper started on - has made the idea of a national newspaper distributed to Christians gathered in churches simply an impossibility.

This week, NewsCorp shuttered over 100 newspapers. 100-year-old papers such as the Gawler Bunyip (my second favourite newspaper name) are disappearing. And so is this one, just a little over ten years old.

But there is good news: [Bible Society Australia](#) is producing a new “Bible Society Magazine” which will include Eternity content, material from the supporters’ magazine “Sower” and part of the Koorong catalogue. It is being sent this week to people on the Sower and Koorong mail lists. People at your church are probably on those lists.



We would very much appreciate you offering this opportunity to your church community also.
